

Marita Dybowska-Dubois is Polish criminal defence lawyer, disciplinary judge, mediator and trainer.

Since 2004 she has worked as an advocate in the field of criminal law, representing both suspects and victims in trials and pre-trails phase of criminal proceedings. Her legal practice is devoted to protection of rights of the suspects

and accused in criminal cases. She has represented clients in the proceedings at the European Court of Human Rights either. As a member of Committee of Human Rights at the National Bar Council till 2011 she worked on the projects in the field of human rights protection. She is engaged in the professor Zbigniew Hołda Association, a partner of Justice Defense Committee (KOS), whose core activity is to counter political – based violation of rights of the members of judicial system. Since 2006 she has cooperated pro bono with the Helsinki Foundation for Human Rights.

Since 2013 Marita Dybowska- Dubois is also a disciplinary judge and the Vice – President of Disciplinary Court at Warsaw Bar Council. Since 2006. she works for Warsaw Bar Council as a trainer for lawyers of the Bar in the field of criminal law, criminal proceedings, human rights violation and recently in the field of alternative dispute solution in criminal proceeding.
